BE it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor of the Terri-Preamble. tory of Papua with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. In addition to the sums authorized by the #14.878 approAppropriation Ordinance, 1919-1920, and the Supplementary priated to the
Appropriation Ordinance, (No. 1), 1919-1920, there shall and
may be issued and applied for the Service of the year
