E it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor of the Terri-Preamble. tory of Papua with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

to this Ordinance any sum or sums not exceeding the sums in the said First Schedule respectively set forth amounting to Four Thousand Two Hundred and Ten Pounds.

Advances for the purposes of the Second Schedule. 2. In addition to the sums specified in the First Schedule to this Ordinance the Treasurer may issue and apply towards making good the supply hereby granted to His Majesty for the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and twenty-one, as advances for the purposes set forth in the Second Schedule to this Ordinance any sum or sums not exceeding the aggregate sum appearing in the said Second Schedule.

Short title.

3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation Ordinance (No. 3), 1920-1921.
