TOBACCO REGULATION. MADE UNDER THE "EXCISE ORDINANCE, 1914."

Tobacco Regulation 19, made under the Excise Ordinance, 1914, and forming portion of Schedule X to that Ordinance, is amended by inserting therein after the word "Spirits" the following words:—

"Acetic Acid, Beeswax, Essential Oils, Glycerine, Gum Arabic, Honey, Molasses, Potassium Acetate, Paraffin-wax, Spermaceti, Salammoniac, Sugar, Saltpetre, Salt."

Passd in Executive Council this twenty-eighth day of February, One thousand nine hundred and eighteen.
