STATUTORY RULES.

No. 15 of 1924.

Made under the Health Ordinance, 1912-1924.

The Health (Tank Accommodation) Regulations, 1924, (Statutory Rules No. 3 of 1924) are amended by inserting after Sub-regulation (1) of Regulation 4 the following sub-regulations:—

"(1A). If at any time it becomes necessary to repair any portion of the tank accommodation provided for any building the owner shall effect the necessary repairs at the earliest opportunity otherwise the occupier shall effect such repairs and may recover from the owner the cost thereof.

(1B). If in the opinion of the Director of Public Works, or the person for the time being acting in the place of the Director of Public Works, any tank forming part of such tank accommodation is useless for the storage of rain-water and cannot be repaired he shall issue a certificate to that effect and thereupon such tank shall cease to form part of the tank accommodation provided for the building."
