

# STATUTORY RULES.

No. 17 of 1921.

## REGULATIONS

Made under the *Land Ordinance*, 1911-1919.

1. All allotments in the township of Samarai are hereby graded as first-class allotments on which improvements are to be not less than One hundred and fifty pounds (£150).

2. All improvements on township allotments, wherever situated, shall be verified by statutory declaration with such detail as the Director of Public Works may in each case prescribe.

3. Regulation made the 19th December, 1906, and gazetted same day, is hereby cancelled in so far as it applies to Paragraph 4—Allotments, Township of Samarai.

Made in Executive Council this twelfth day of December, One thousand nine hundred and twenty-one.
