STATUTORY RULES. No. 12 of 1930.

Made under The Mining Act of 1898 (Queensland Adopted).

The $Mining\ Regulations$ (Statutory Rules No. 5 of 1923), are further amended as tollows:—

- 1. By inserting in Sub-regulation (1) of Regulation 110 thereof immediately after the word "neighbourhood" therein the following proviso:—
 - "Provided that the Warden may upon application if the circumstances in a particular case so require dispense with the posting of the said notices on the leasehold as aforesaid and may direct such other mode of publication in lieu thereof as he thinks fit."
 - 2. This regulation shall be deemed to have come into operation on the first day of April, One thousand nine hundred and thirty.
