STATUTORY RULES.

No. 12 of 1931.

Made under The Mining Act of 1898 (Queensland Adopted).

The Mining Regulations (Statutory Rules No. 5 of 1923), are further amended:—

1. By inserting immediately after Regulation 101 thereof the following new Regulation:—

"101A. The Director of Mines may delay his instructions for survey until the Warden has held a preliminary hearing of the application and has notified him that such objections if any that could at this stage be dealt with have been disposed of and that the formalities of the application have been complied with provided that in any such case the labour conditions shall commence at a date not later than seven days after notice to the applicant that a lease will be granted, unless exemption is granted."
