

# STATUTORY RULES.

## No. 9 of 1928.

Made under *The Mining Act of 1898* (Queensland adopted).

The Mining Regulations (Statutory Rules No. 5 of 1923) are amended as follows:—

By inserting in Sub-regulation (2) of Regulation 58 after the words "period of seven clear days" the following new provisos:—

"Provided that the Warden may upon application if the circumstances so require extend any or all of such periods of seven days: Provided further that the Warden may upon like conditions dispense with the posting of the true copy of the certificate as aforesaid and direct such other mode of publication in lieu thereof as he thinks fit."
