STATUTORY RULES.

No. 19 of 1923.

Made under the Native (Half-Caste) Children Ordinance, 1922.

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Native (Half-Caste) Children Regulations, 1923.
 - 2. (1) In these Regulations unless the context otherwise indicates or requires—
 "Commissioner" means the Commissioner of Native Affairs and Control.
 - "The Ordinance" means the Native (Half-Caste) Children Ordinance, 1922.
- (2) In these Regulations the terms used respectively shall have the same meanings as are assigned to them by the Ordinance.
- 3. The moneys received by the Commissioner under the provisions of the Ordinance shall be paid by him into an account, to be called the "Native (Half-Caste) Children Account," to be kept in the Commonwealth Bank of Australia Savings Bank Department, Port Moresby, or in some other Bank at Port Moresby approved by the Lieutenant-Governor.
 - 4. The said account shall be operated on by the Commissioner.
- 5. The Commissioner shall cause to be kept proper and full accounts of all moneys received by him under the Ordinance and of all expenditure thereof.
- 6. The moneys paid to the Commissioner in respect of any neglected half-caste child under the provisions of the Ordinance shall (after payment into the said account) be expended by him in or towards the maintenance or advancement in life or otherwise for the benefit of such neglected half-caste child.
