

STATUTORY RULES.

No. 10 of 1918.

REGULATIONS

Made under *The Native Regulation Ordinance of 1908* (No. XXV. of 1909).

1. The Regulations dealing with Native Matters made under *The Native Regulation Ordinance of 1908*, on the fifteenth day of March, 1911, and published in the *Gazette* dated the twenty-fourth day of April, 1911, are further amended by omitting from paragraph (6) of regulation 84 all the words commencing "be liable to a fine" down to the end of the paragraph, and by inserting in their stead the words "for a first offence be liable to a fine not exceeding Five shillings or in default of payment to imprisonment for any period not exceeding six weeks or to such imprisonment in the first instance; or, for a second or any subsequent offence to imprisonment in the first instance for any period not exceeding three months."

Made and passed in Executive Council this twenty-ninth day of August, One thousand nine hundred and eighteen.
