STATUTORY RULES.

Made under the The Native Regulation Ordinance of 1908.

The Native Regulations, 1922 (Statutory Rules No. 3 of 1922), are further amended by adding immediately at the end of Sub-Regulation (1) of Regulation 96 thereof, the following proviso:

"Provided however that the teacher of the school or the magistrate may excuse the attendance of any child for so long as in his opinion such attendance would interfere with the proper observance of a recognized native ceremony."

Made in Executive Council this sixth day of August, One thousand nine hundred and twenty-nine.
