STATUTORY RULES. No. 17 of 1929.

Made under the Native Taxes Ordinance, 1917-1924.

The Native Taxes (Funds) Regulations, 1926 (Statutory Rules No. 13 of 1926), are further amended by— $\,$

1. adding immediately after Regulation 32 thereof the following new regulation and heading:—

Encouragement of thrift.

33. The authorized sum may be expended annually out of the Native Benefits Fund for the purpose of encouraging thrift amongst natives."

2. inserting in the Schedule thereto after the line representing Item 16 under the heading NATIVE BENEFITS FUND the following new line:—

"33 | - | - | - | Encouragement of thrift | 17 | £50 | - | -"
