

# STATUTORY RULES.

## No. 8 of 1928.

Made under *The Native Taxes Ordinance, 1917-1924.*

The *Native Taxes (Funds) Regulations, 1926* (Statutory Rules No. 13 of 1926), are further amended as follows:—

1. (a) By adding after Regulation 13 thereof the following new regulation and heading:—

*“Papuan School Reader.*

13A. The authorized sum may be paid out of the Native Education Fund towards the cost of publication by the Government Printer of the first edition of the *Papuan School Reader*. Such payment shall not be recurrent. Any payments made during the financial year 1927-1928 shall be deemed to have been made in pursuance of this Regulation.”

- (b) By inserting in the Schedule thereto after the line representing item 7 under the heading NATIVE EDUCATION FUND the following new line:—

“13A | - | - | - | *Papuan School Reader* | 7A | £400 | - | - ”

2. (a) By adding after Regulation 27A thereof under the heading *London Missionary Society—Fife Bay Hospital*, the following new regulation:—

“27B. The authorized sum may be annually paid out of the Native Benefits Fund to the London Missionary Society towards the upkeep and maintenance of the Native Hospital at Fife Bay.”

- (b) By inserting in the Schedule thereto after the line representing item 12A under the heading NATIVE BENEFITS FUND the following new line:—

“27B | - | - | - | London Missionary Society—Subsidy Fife  
Bay Hospital ... .. | 12B | £100 | - | - ”
