Made under the Post and Telegraph Ordinance, 1912-1920.

The Postal Regulations, 1923 (Statutory Rules No. 22 of 1923) are amended as follows:—

- (1) Regulation 117 and the heading "Mail Notice" is repealed.
- (2) Regulation 118 is repealed and the following Regulation is made in lieu thereof:—

"118. The rates of payment to masters of vessels for the carriage of mails in cases not provided for by contract shall be as follow:—

Letters and post cards ...

8d. per lb.

Other articles ...

.. 1s. 4d. per cwt."
