## STATUTORY RULES. No. 11 of 1940.

Made under the Post and Telegraph Ordinance, 1912-1930.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Parcels Post Regulations, 1940.

2. The Parcels Post Regulations made the nineteenth September, 1911, and published in *Gazette* of the fourth October, 1911, are amended by adding the following proviso to Regulation 25 thereof:—

"Provided that where the amount of duty on a foreign parcel arriving as aforesaid addressed to a Member of His Majesty's Forces in the Territory does not exceed Three shillings such parcel may be delivered free."
