STATUTORY RULES.

No. 7 of 1925.

Made under the Port Moresby Electric Light and Power Ordinance, 1925.

The $Electricity\ Regulations$, 1925 (Statutory Rules No. 3 of 1925), are amended as follows:—

- 1. By omitting from Regulation 2 the paragraph dealing with Off-Peak rate and inserting in lieu thereof the following paragraph:—
 - "Off-Peak: When the consumer uses electrical energy only at such times and under such conditions as may be specially determined by the Electric Authority the rate of charge shall be Threepence (3d.) per Unit. The acceptance of applications for the supply of electrical energy at the Off-Peak rate shall be subject to the discretion of the Electric Authority. This paragraph dealing with Off-Peak rate shall be deemed to have come into operation on the first day of May, One thousand nine hundred and twenty-five."
- 2. By omitting from Regulation 46 the words "(See Clause 8—Terms and Conditions of Supply)."
