STATUTORY RULES. No. 16 of 1919.

REGULATIONS

Made under the Prisons Ordinance, 1919 (No. IV. of 1919).

"205. The hours of labour shall be 7 a.m. to 1 p.m. and from 2 p.m. to 5 p.m., and on Saturdays from 7 a.m. until noon. Prisoners shall only do necessary cleaning on Sundays, Christmas Day and Good Friday; on other holidays they shall work as on non-holidays unless the Government Secretary otherwise directs."

Made in Council this twenty-fourth day of September, One thousand nine hundred and nineteen.
