STATUTORY RULES. No. 4 of 1924.

Regulations made under the *Prisons Ordinance*, 1919 (No. 4 of 1919).

The Prisons Regulations, 1919 (Statutory Rules No. 13 of 1919) are amended by the omission of the words contained in Regulation 88 (a) and the insertion in lieu thereof of the following words:—

"A penalty not exceeding Two pounds and in default of payment to imprisonment with or without hard labour for a period not exceeding three months or to such imprisonment without being fined."
