

STATUTORY RULES.

No. 4 of 1924.

Regulations made under the *Prisons Ordinance*, 1919
(No. 4 of 1919).

The *Prisons Regulations*, 1919 (Statutory Rules No. 13 of 1919) are amended by the omission of the words contained in Regulation 88 (a) and the insertion in lieu thereof of the following words :—

“A penalty not exceeding Two pounds and in default of payment to imprisonment with or without hard labour for a period not exceeding three months or to such imprisonment without being fined.”
