STATUTORY RULES. No. 10 of 1923.

Made under the Public Service Ordinance of 1907 (No. 2 of 1907).

The *Public Service Regulations*, 1922 (Statutory Rules No. 2 of 1923) as amended by Statutory Rules No. 6 of 1923 are amended—

- (a) by inserting in the first column of Schedule B thereto above the word "Blacksmith" the words "Engineer, Official Vessel";
- (b) by inserting in the second column of Schedule B opposite the words "Engineer, Official Vessel" so inserted the figures and word "500 to 560"; and
- (c) by inserting in the third, fourth, fifth and sixth columns respectively of Schedule B opposite the words "Engineer, Official Vessel" so inserted the figures "15."
