

STATUTORY RULES.

No. 3 of 1926.

Made under *The Public Service Ordinance of 1907* (No. 2 of 1907).

1. The *Public Service Regulations, 1922* (Statutory Rules No. 2 of 1923), are amended as follows:—

(a) By inserting at the end of the Schedule to Part II thereof the following:—
“DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS.

HEAD OF DEPARTMENT—The Director of Public Works.

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| 1. Works and Buildings—Design, Construction and Maintenance. | 7. Town Cleaning, Port Moresby. |
| 2. Roads and Bridges—Location, Construction and Maintenance. | 8. Vessels, Boats and Launches—Construction and Overhaul. |
| 3. Streets and Footpaths—Construction and Maintenance. | 9. Sheet Metal and Smithy Work, Cabinet Making and Joinery. |
| 4. Sewerage and Drainage. | 10. Wharves and Jetties—Construction and Maintenance. |
| 5. Water Supply. | 11. Buoys and Beacons—Erection and Maintenance.” |
| 6. Town Lighting (Port Moresby and Samarai). | |

(b) By inserting at the end of the first column of the scale in Sub-regulation (1) of Regulation 22 the words “Director of Public Works” and by inserting at the end of the second column thereof the figures “1 0 0.”

2. Statutory Rules No. 12 of 1924 and published in *Gazette* No. 11 of 3rd September, 1924, are hereby repealed.
