

STATUTORY RULES.

No. 4 of 1938.

Made under *The Public Service Ordinance of 1907.*

The *Public Service Regulations, 1926* (Statutory Rules No. 9 of 1926), are further amended as follows:—

1. By repealing Sub-regulation (2) of Regulation 23A and substituting the following in its stead:—

“(2) The salary increment provided in this regulation shall cease to be payable to the extent by which its addition to the salary of the officer exceeds Five hundred and ten pounds annually.”

2. This regulation shall be deemed to have come into force on the first day of January, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-six.
