

STATUTORY RULES.

No. 6 of 1940.

Made under *The Public Service Ordinance of 1907* (No. 2 of 1907).

The *Public Service Regulations, 1939* (Statutory Rules No. 12 of 1939), are amended as follows:—

1. By omitting from Sub-regulation (3) of Regulation 21 the words:—

“Notwithstanding anything contained in the foregoing, persons under the age of twenty-one years appointed to a position of Cadet may be paid salary according to the following scale:—”

and substituting the following words in their stead:—

“Notwithstanding anything elsewhere contained in these regulations any officer under the age of twenty-one years shall be deemed only to hold office as a Cadet and may as such be paid salary according to the following scale:—”.
