

STATUTORY RULES.

No. 6 of 1926.

Made under the *Quarantine Ordinance*, 1913-1922.

The *Quarantine Regulations*, 1922 (Statutory Rules No. 1 of 1923), as amended by Statutory Rules No. 4 of 1926, are further amended by adding after Part III thereof the following new Regulations:—

“PART IIIA.—QUARANTINE AREAS.

35B. No person shall enter into or depart from any Quarantine Area without the permission in writing of a Quarantine Officer or other officer for the time being in charge of the Quarantine Area.

35C. Any person who enters or departs from a Quarantine Area with the written permission of a Quarantine Officer or other officer for the time being in charge of the Quarantine Area shall comply with any conditions or restrictions contained in the written permission.

35D. For the purposes of this Part of these Regulations ‘Quarantine Area’ means any part of the Territory proclaimed to be a Quarantine Area.”
