No. 17 of 1919.

REGULATIONS

Made under the *Quarantine Ordinance*, 1913.

(No. VI. of 1913.)

The Quarantine Regulations adopted by the *Quarantine Ordinance*, 1913, as amended by Statutory Rules No. 5 of 1919, are amended as follows:—

Regulation 14 is amended by omitting therefrom the words "10 days if such disease is Spanish Influenza" and inserting in lieu thereof the words "3 days if such disease is Spanish Influenza."
