

STATUTORY RULES.

No. 16 of 1929.

Made under the *Roads Ordinance*, 1916.

The *Motor-Vehicles Regulations*, 1925 (Statutory Rules No. 18 of 1925), are amended as follows :—

1. By inserting therein immediately after Regulation Sixteen thereof the following new regulation and heading :—

“Cancellation of licence.”

16A. The Registrar may at his discretion suspend or cancel any licence issued to a person who in his opinion is from any cause whatsoever unfit to hold such licence.”

2. This regulation shall be deemed to have come into operation from the first day of May, One thousand nine hundred and twenty-nine.
