

RULES OF COURT (MATRIMONIAL CAUSES) 1934.⁽¹⁾

1. These Rules may be cited as the *Rules of Court (Matrimonial Causes) 1934.*⁽¹⁾ Citation.

2. The Rules of Court of the Supreme Court of Queensland,⁽²⁾ in force in Queensland on the fifth day of December, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-two and regulating the— Queensland practice &c. to apply.

(a) practice, pleading and procedure; and

(b) costs to be allowed and paid to solicitors in any proceeding—

in, or in relation to, matrimonial actions in the said Supreme Court shall, so far as they are applicable, apply to and regulate the practice, pleading and procedure and the costs to be allowed and paid to solicitors, in any proceeding under the *Divorce and Matrimonial Causes Ordinance 1934.*

3. Where, in any case there is no provision under these Rules which is applicable to any matter of practice, procedure or costs, any party may apply to a Judge in Chambers for directions. Application to Judge for directions.
