 $\mathbf{B}^{\mathbf{E}}$ it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Territory of New Guinea, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the New Guinea Act 1920-1932, as follows :----

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the Land Ordinance Short title and citation. 1935.(1)

(2.) The Land Ordinance 1922-1933 is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the Land Ordinance 1922-1935.
