

LAWS REPEAL AND ADOPTING ORDINANCE
1939.⁽¹⁾

No. 15 of 1939.

An Ordinance to amend the Laws Repeal and Adopting Ordinance 1921-1937.

BE it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Territory of New Guinea, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *New Guinea Act 1920-1935*, as follows:—

Short title and citation.

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Laws Repeal and Adopting Ordinance 1939*.⁽¹⁾

(2.) The *Laws Repeal and Adopting Ordinance 1921-1937* is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Laws Repeal and Adopting Ordinance 1921-1939*.

Amendment of Third Schedule to Principal Ordinance.

3.—(1.) The Third Schedule to the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting the words and figures “*Weights and Measures Ordinance 1913*.”

(2.) This section shall not commence until a date to be fixed by the Administrator by notice in the *New Guinea Gazette*.⁽¹⁾
