- 2.—(1.) The person in charge of a mission school shall, within Person in two months after the first day of January in each year, furnish to the charge of mission school District Officer administering the District in which the mission school to furnish returns. is situated, returns in accordance with Forms A and B in the Schedule to these Regulations.

Penalty: Ten pounds.

(2.) Any person who wilfully makes a declaration incomplete or false in any material particular shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty: Ten pounds.

- (3.) No prosecution for an offence under this regulation shall be commenced without the authority in writing of the Director of District Services and Native Affairs.
