

# REGULATION<sup>(1)</sup> (PAPUA, ADOPTED) UNDER THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ORDINANCE, 1912-1916 IN ITS APPLICATION TO THE TERRITORY OF NEW GUINEA.

The notice in writing to be given under Section 69(1) of the above-mentioned Ordinance by the master of any vessel which is under 20 tons measurement and not at that time or ordinarily used for the carriage of passengers or freight for hire and which is about to depart from a port within the Territory to another port or place therein shall be one hour and shall commence and expire between the hours of nine o'clock in the morning and five o'clock in the afternoon.
