POST AND TELEGRAPH ORDINANCE 1933. (1)

No. 9 of 1933.

An Ordinance to amend the Post and Telegraph Ordinance 1923.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the New Guinea Act 1920-1926, as follows:—

Short title and citation.

- 1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be eited as the Post and Telegraph Ordinance 1933.⁽¹⁾
- (2.) The Post and Telegraph Ordinance 1923 is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.
- (3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the Post and Telegraph Ordinance 1923-1933.

Validation of certain regulations.

4. Where the Administrator purporting to act under the Principal Ordinance or under the Principal Ordinance and the Post and Telegraph Ordinance, 1912-1916, of the Territory of Papua in its application to the Territory has made any regulations, (3) such regulations shall be deemed to be and to have been of the same force and effect as if the Post and Telegraph Ordinance 1923-1933 had been in force on the date on which they were made, and as if they had been made by the Administrator under the Papuan Ordinance, as amended by that Ordinance.
