

POLICE FORCE—

AMENDMENT OF POLICE FORCE
REGULATIONS. ⁽¹⁾

1. * * * * *

Accrued rights to be subject to discretion of Superintendent of Police.

2. Notwithstanding the terms of the proviso omitted by the last preceding regulation, any grant of local leave already accrued under the omitted proviso shall be subject to the discretion of the Superintendent of Police.

(a) "This set of Regulations stated in its introductory part that it was "to come into operation forthwith." At the relevant dates in 1933 Section 53 of the *Police Force Ordinance 1930-1940* (under which this set of Regulations was made) provided that "Regulations made under this Section shall—(a) be published in the *New Guinea Gazette*; and (b) take effect from the date of publication, or from a date specified therein." At the relevant dates in 1933 there was no other Ordinance or regulation of general application providing for the publication of regulations, the date on which they took effect, or the meaning of "forthwith."

(2) Regulation 1 amends Regulation 42 of the *Police Force Regulations* by repealing the proviso thereto and substituting in its stead a new proviso, and the amendment so made is incorporated therein.
