

ROADS REGULATIONS.⁽¹⁾

Regulations 1937, No. 13.

1.—These Regulations may be cited as the Roads Regulations.⁽¹⁾ short title.

2.--(1.) Except within the boundaries of any town, no person Prohibition of shall, without the written consent of a District Officer previously obtained, use any road for the transport of coconuts or copra between the hours of 7 p.m. and 5.30 a.m.

Penalty: Fifty pounds or imprisonment for six months.

(2.) Where any agent or employee contravenes, in the course of his employment, the provisions of this regulation, his principal or employer, as the case may be, shall be deemed to be guilty of an offence and shall, as well as such agent or employee, be liable to the penalty prescribed in this regulation.

(3.) For the purposes of this regulation-

"coconut" shall include any part of a coconut; and

"road" shall mean any road or track used by, or open to the use of, the public.
