SLAUGHTERING ORDINANCE 1925. (1)

No. 31 of 1925.

An Ordinance to repeal the Slaughtering Ordinance 1917, and for other purposes.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General of the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Commonwealth Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the New Guinea Act 1920, as follows:-

- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Slaughtering Ordinance Short title. $1925.^{(1)}$
- 2. This Ordinance shall be deemed to have commenced on the Commencement. first day of December, One thousand nine hundred and twentythree.
 - 3. The Slaughtering Ordinance 1917 is repealed:

Repeal.

Provided that nothing in this Ordinance shall affect the validity of any licence granted under that Ordinance prior to the commencement of this Ordinance.

4. Regulations 1, and 3 to 22 inclusive, of the Slaughtering validation of Regulations 1923, (2) and the Schedules to those Regulations, shall be deemed to be as valid and effectual as if this Ordinance had been in force at the date upon which it is deemed to have commenced.
