

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE COURTS AND LAWS ADOPTING ORDINANCE OF 1888.⁽¹⁾

No. 1 of 1889.

An Ordinance to amend "The Courts and Laws Adopting Ordinance of 1888."

BE it enacted by the Administrator of British New Guinea with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. Notwithstanding anything contained in Section 14 of Ordinance 4 of 1888 intituled *The Courts and Laws Adopting Ordinance of 1888*, Sections 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 and 12 of the said Ordinance are hereby put and declared to be in force and operation.

Putting in force certain sections of Ordinance 4 of 1888.

2. The Central Court⁽²⁾ referred to in said Ordinance 4 of 1888 is to be deemed as established and in existence from the date of the coming into force of this Ordinance.
