AN ACT to appropriate five million five hundred and fifty one thousand five hundred and sixty five dollars to the service of the year ending the 31st December 1984.

ENACTED by the National Parliament of Solomon Islands.

Short title. 1. This Act may be cited as the 1984 Supplementary Appropriation Act 1984.

Authorisation of issue from the Consolidated Fund of \$5,551,565 the service of 1984.

 The issue from the Consolidated Fund is hereby authorised of a sum of five million five hundred and fifty one thousand five hundred and sixty five dollars to be applied to the service of the year ending 31st December 1984.

Appropriation.

3. The sum specified in the preceding section shall be appropriated for the supply of the heads specified, and in and amounts respectively specified in relation thereto, in the Schedule.

Development Loans. 4. (1) The Government may, in addition to its borrowing under the provisions of section 4, borrow or enter into agreements to borrow on such terms and conditions as it may determine amounts up to such sums of money for such purposes and from such sources as are respectively specified in the first, second and third columns of the second schedule.
