AN ACT to amend the Immigration Act 1978.

ENACTED by the National Parliament of Solomon Islands.

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Immigration (Amendment) Act 1987 and shall come into operation on such day as the Minister may by notice in the Gazette appoint.

2. Subsection (3) of section 9 of the Immigration Act is hereby amended in the following respects -

- (a) by deleting the words "two months" and substituting therefor the words "three months";
- (b) by deleting the fullstop appearing at the end of that subsection and substituting therefor a colon; and
- (c) by adding thereto next after the colon so inserted the following proviso.

"Provided that the Principal Immigration Officer may extend the period or aggregate periods for a further period or aggregate periods not exceeding three months if he is satisfied that there exist special circumstances justifying the extension."
