

1. This Act may be cited as the Public Holidays (Amendment) Act 1982 and shall come into effection the first day of April 1982.

Transfer of power from Governor General to Minister.

- 2. (1) In the proviso to section 2 of the Public Holidays Act (hereafter referred to as the principal Act) for "Governor General" substitute "Minister".
- (2) Section 2(2) of the Principal Act (birthday of Heir to the Throne) is repealed.
- (3) In section 6 of the principal Act for "Governor General" substitute "Minister".

Minister may amend the Schedule. 3. After section 6 of the principal Act insert the following new section -

"Power of Minister to amend the Schedule. 6A. The Minister may by order amend the Schedule to this Act."

Parliamentary procedure.

4. After section 7 of the principal Act insert the following new section -

"Exclusion of section 56 of the Interpretation and General Provisions Act 1978. 8. Section 56 of the Interpretation and General Provisions Act (Parliamentary procedure) shall not apply to subsidiary legislation made under this Act, except that Orders made under section 6A shall be laid before Parliament before they come into effect."
