AN ACT To Provide for the variation of heads of expenditure and appropriate forty seven million, forty six thousand seven hundred and thirteen dollars authorised under the 1994 Appropriation Act 1993 for the service of the year ending 31st December 1994.

ENACTED by the National Parliament of Solomon Islands.

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the 1994 Supplementary Appropriation (No. 2) (Variation of Heads of Expenditure) Act 1994.

Authorisation of issue from the Consolidated Fund of \$47,046,713 to the service of 1994. 2. The issue from the Consolidated Fund is hereby authorised of the sum of forty seven million and forty six thousand, seven hundred and thirteen dollars to be applied to the service of the year ending 31st December 1994.

Appropriation.

3. The sum specified in the preceding section shall be deemed to have been appropriated as from the date of passing this Act for supply of the heads specified and in the amounts respectively specified in relation thereto in the Schedule to this Act.

Sums granted under this Act to be applied to make up deficiency or expenditure. 4. All sums granted by this Act (not being further sums granted by the 1994 Appropriation Act 1993) shall be applied either in making up any deficiency or in defraying expenditure in certain departments or ministries which is due to the variation of heads of expenditure in consequence of the reorganisation of the administration of the departments of the Government.
