PUBLIC FINANCE ADMINISTRATION (PUBLIC STORES) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2000

GS 5A of 2000

PUBLIC FINANCE ADMINISTRATION ACT (CAP. 65)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 10 of the Public Finance Administration Act (Cap. 65), the Minister of Finance with the consent of His Majesty in Council makes the following Regulations:

1.
 - (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Public Finance Administration (Public Stores) (Amendment) Regulations 2000.
 - (2) The Public Finance Administration (Public Stores) Regulations (Cap. 65) is in these Regulations referred to as the Principal Regulations.
2. Regulations 3, 4 and 5 of the Principal Regulations are amended by deleting the words “Government Supply Officer” and substituting “Head of Department”.
3. Regulation 8 of the Principal Regulations is repealed and substituted by the following regulations:

“8.

The Head of Department shall maintain a proper register of all public stores belonging to the Department.

9.

- (1) The Head of Department shall submit to the Standing Board of Survey a list of the public stores recommended for disposal.
- (2) The submission from the Head of Departments shall include the following information:
 - (i) type of public stores;
 - (ii) date of purchase or acquisition;
 - (iii) estimated economic life;
 - (iv) cost price and relevant invoice;
 - (v) recommended disposal value; and
 - (vi) recommended method of disposal.

10.

- (1) The Standing Board of Survey shall inspect deteriorating, obsolete and surplus public stores. A report by the Standing Board of Survey shall be made to the Minister of the Department concerned, on the disposal or destruction of such public stores.
- (2) Such public stores shall be disposed of by public tender or auction or trade-in or if unsuitable for sale shall be destroyed in the presence of at least one member or nominee of the Board.”
