



RAFFLES (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 1998

GS 5B of 1998

RAFFLES ACT

[3rd August 1998]

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on him by Section 7 of the Raffles Act (Cap. 169), the Minister of Police makes the following regulations:

1.

- (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Raffles (Amendment) Regulations 1998.
- (2) The Raffles Regulations (Cap. 169) are in these Regulations referred to as the Principal Regulations.

2. The Principal Regulations are amended by adding the following as Regulation 16:

“16.

These Regulations do not apply to instant lottery or pool betting”.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

(These notes do not form part of the Regulations but is intended only to explain its general purpose.)

1. This amendment makes only one change to the Regulations by inserting a new section (16), because the current regulations are not appropriate for the scratch lotto scheme to be introduced in the Kingdom.
2. Clause 2 of the amendment ensures that these Regulations shall not apply to scratch lotto and pool betting (inserted in anticipation of future amendments) as these will have their own regulations.
