THE COMPANIES (WINDING-UP) (AMENDMENT) RULES 1977

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon me by section 435(1) of the Companies Regulation (as construed by section 4(1) of the High Court of the New Hebrides Regulation 1976 (No. 2 of 1976)) I, Louis Georges SOUYAVE, Knight, the Judge of the High Court of the New Hebrides, hereby make the following Rules:—

Short title  
and  
commencement.

1. These Rules may be cited as the Companies (Winding-up) (Amendment) Rules 1977, and shall come into operation on 1st December 1977.

2. The Companies (Winding-up) Rules 1949 in their application in the New Hebrides are amended by inserting the following rule immediately after rule 37 -

"Power of  
registrar of  
companies to  
withdraw  
petition.

37A. Where the registrar of companies has presented a petition for the winding up of a company on the ground that the company has failed to comply with one or more requirements of the Companies Regulation, the Court may direct the registrar to withdraw that petition if the Court has been informed in writing by the registrar that the company has subsequently complied with the requirement or requirements upon which the petition was grounded. "
