QUEEN'S REGULATION

TO AMEND the Stamp Duties Regulation

MADE BY Her Britannic Majesty's Resident Commissioner in the New Hebrides in pursuance of the powers contained in the New Hebrides Orders. In the name of Her Majesty Elizabeth the Second, by the Grace of God of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and Her other Realms and Territories Queen, Head of the Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith.

1. This Regulation may be cited as the Stamp Duties (Amendment) Regulation 1978 and upon its prior publication by the Resident Commissioner causing a copy thereof to be exhibited at the Public Office of the Resident Commissioner shall come into operation on the 1st day of January 1979.

2. The Schedule to the Stamp Duties Regulation is amended -

- (i) by deleting in the second column under the subheading "DECLARATION OF TRUST" both entries opposite items (2) (a) and (b) and replacing them by -
 - (a) 20 cents, subject to a minimum fee of \$10,
 - (b) 40 cents, subject to a minimum fee of \$10;

- (ii) in the second column under the subheading "TRANSFER OF PROPERTY" by deleting in paragraph 1 in the second column the figure "\$5" and substituting therefor "\$10", and in paragraph 3 by deleting the figure "\$5" and substituting therefor the figure "\$10";
- (iii) in the second column under the sub-heading "SETTLEMENTS" by adding after the figure "40c", "subject to a minimum fee of \$50".
