JOINT REGULATION

To bring into effect the Estimates of the Joint Administration in the year 1964.

[Published: Condominium Gazette No. 222.]

MADE by the British and French Resident Commissioners under the provisions of Articles 5, 7, paragraph 2 of Article 2 of the Anglo-French Protocol of 1914 and section 5 of the Joint Finance Regulation No. 10 of 1957, after consultation of the Advisory Council and with the approval of the Governments of Her Britannic Majesty and of the French Republic.

1. This Regulation may be cited as the 1964 Appropriation oint Regulation.

2. The Estimates of the Joint Administration for the year 1964 hall provide for—

- (a) Revenue to the amount of Seven Hundred and Eighty-Two Thousand Seven Hundred Pounds Sterling (£Stg. 782,700) or One Hundred and Ninety-Five Million Six Hundred and Seventy-Five Thousand New Hebrides Francs (195,675,000 FNH).
- (b) Expenditure to the amount of Seven Hundred and Eighty-Two Thousand Seven Hundred Pounds Sterling (£Stg. 782,700) or One Hundred and Ninety-Five Million Six Hundred and Seventy-Five Thousand New Hebrides Frances (195,675,000 FNH).

3. There shall be issued from general revenue and other funds the Joint Administration and applied to the service of the year ding 31st December, 1964 a sum not exceeding that specified in of section 2 of this Joint Regulation. The said amount shall be propriated as set out in the schedule to this Joint Regulation.

4. The Ordonnateur shall authorise expenditure and the easurer shall pay such sum or sums of money as the Resident immissioners jointly by warrant from time to time direct for the impose aforesaid not exceeding on the whole the sum specified in of Section 2.
