## JOINT REGULATION

To control the catching of crayfish (spiny lobsters).
Published: Condominium Gazette No. 273. Amended by Joint
Regulation No. 31 of 1973 (Condominium Gazette No. 328).]

Mape by the Resident Commissioners under the provisions of sparagraph 2 of Article 2 and Article 7 of the Anglo-French Protocol of 1914.

1. For the purposes of this Regulation the following expresslons shall have the meanings respectively assigned to them-
CCrayfish" means a crayfish of the genus Penulirus (spiny lobster) an䅫这 illustration of which is contained in Schedule I to this RegulaWhtion;
dprotected waters" means-
To the North: The parallel $13^{\circ}$ South limited to the East by ten medidian $167^{\circ} 50^{\prime}$ East and to the West by the median $166^{\circ} 20^{\prime}$ East.

To the East: The meridian $167^{\circ} 50^{\prime}$ East from the point of its intersection with the parallel $13^{\circ}$ South to its intersection with the parallel $14^{\circ}$ South.
The parallel $14^{\circ}$ South to its intersection with the meridian $168^{\circ} 30^{\prime}$ East.
The meridian $168^{\circ} 30^{\prime}$ East to its intersection with the parallel $16^{\circ}$ South.
The parallel $16^{\circ}$ South to its intersection with the meridian $168^{\circ} 50^{\prime}$ East.
The meridian $168^{\circ} 50^{\prime}$ East from its intersection with the parallel $16^{\circ}$ South to its intersection with the parallel $18^{\circ}$ South.
The parallel $18^{\circ}$ South to its intersection with the meridian $170^{\circ} 20^{\prime}$ East.
The meridian $170^{\circ} 20^{\prime}$ East to its intersection with the parallel $20^{\circ} 25^{\prime}$ South.

To the South: The parallel $20^{\circ} 25^{\prime}$ South limited to the East by the meridian $170^{\circ} 20^{\prime}$ East and to the West by the meridian $168^{\circ} 40^{\prime}$ East.
the West: The meridian $166^{\circ} 20^{\prime}$ East from its intersection with the parallel $13^{\circ}$ South to its intersection with the parallel $16^{\circ} 50^{\prime}$ South.

The parallel $16^{\circ} 50^{\prime}$ South to its intersection with the meridian $168^{\circ}$ East.
The meridian $168^{\circ}$ East from its intersection with parallel $16^{\circ} 50^{\prime}$ South to the parallel $18^{\circ}$ South.
The parallel $18^{\circ}$ South from the meridian $168^{\circ}$ East to the meridian $168^{\circ} 40^{\prime}$ East.
The parallel $18^{\circ}$ South from the meridian $168^{\circ}$ East to the meridian $168^{\circ} 40^{\prime}$ East.
The meridian $168^{\circ} 40^{\prime}$ East from the intersection with parallel $18^{\circ}$ South to the parallel $20^{\circ} 25^{\prime}$ South.
The said waters being more particularly delineated on the map contained in Schedule II to this Regulation.
2. (1) No person shall in protected waters catch-
(a) any female crayfish carrying eggs between or attached to the abdominal swimmerets; or
(b) any crayfish the total length of the carapace of which, measured from immediately behind the rostral horns to the rear edge of the carapace in the mid-line, is less than $2 \frac{1}{2}$ inches or of which the total length, measured from immediately behind the rostral horns to the rear edge of the telson, is less than 8 inches.
(2) Without prejudice to the provisions of the immediately preceding subsection of this section no person shall in protected waters catch any crayfish between the 1st day of [November] of any Seear and the 28th day of February of the following year.
3. [(1) Any person who acts in contravention of the proStisions of this regulation shall be guilty of an offence and on conWhiction thereof shall be liable to a fine not exceeding $25,000 \mathrm{FNH}$ Or the equivalent in Australian dollars at the official rate of exchange. Wh the case of a second or subsequent offence the amount of such Whe may be doubled.]
(2) Any person who knowingly sells or purchases any crayfish塋这ght in contravention of the provisions of the immediately yteceding section of this Regulation shall be guilty of an offence and fo conviction thereof shall be liable to a fine not exceeding two Windred pounds or its equivalent in francs at the current rate of trchange.
4. The District Agents and their representatives within their \% \%epective Districts, police officers, members of the Department of siniculture and Animal Husbandry and Customs Officers are Marged with the execution of this Regulation.
5. The Resident Commissioners may make Joint Rules for Rules. better carrying out of this Regulation.
6. This Regulation may be cited as the Joint Control of Citation. Crayfish Catching Regulation No. 17 of 1968 and shall come into preration on the date of its publication in the Condominium Gazette.
