JOINT REGULATION

No. 14 of

To control nocturnal noise within the town limits of Vila and Santo.

[Published: Condominium Gazette No. 233.]

MADE by the Resident Commissioners under the provisions of paragraph 2 of Article 2 and Article 7 of the Anglo-French Protocol of 1914.

1. No person shall within the town limits of Vila or Santo and within two kilometres of the said limits between the hours of nine o'clock in the evening and five o'clock of the following morning sing, shout, play a musical instrument, sound a motor horn except when becessary to avoid an accident, or make any other unreasonable so as to cause annoyance to the inhabitants of the said town.

Prohibition of nocturnal noise.

2. Any person who acts in contravention of the provisions of is Regulation shall be guilty of an offence and on conviction thereof all be liable to a fine not exceeding £10 sterling or its equivalent francs at the current rate of exchange.

Penalties.

3. This Regulation may be cited as the Joint Control of octurnal Noise Regulation No. 14 of 1965 and shall come into cration on the date of its publication in the Condominium azette.
