## A JOINT REGULATION

No. 1 of

published: Condominium Gazette No. 124.]

Issued by the Resident Commissioners in accordance with the provisions of Article 7 of the Anglo-French Protocol of 1914.

- 1. Whenever it shall appear desirable to the Resident Commisioners that any block of land or any portion thereof should be fenced the Resident Commissioners acting jointly may serve or cause be served by any person authorised by them notice on the owner or occupier of any such land to erect fences in accordance with the terms and specifications prescribed in the said notice.
- 2. Whenever it shall appear desirable to them the Resident Commissioners acting jointly may serve or cause to be served by any person authorised by them notice on the owner of or occupier of any and requiring him to maintain his fences and gates in a good and sufficient state of repair.
- 3. Any person who fails to comply with the terms of or prevents or obstructs the execution of the terms of any notice issued and duly served under this Regulation shall be guilty of an offence under this Regulation.
- 4. In the event of failure to comply with any of the terms of any notice issued and duly served under this Regulation the Resident Commissioners may take or cause to be taken such steps as may be required to ensure the execution of any work required by such notice, the cost or which shall be recoverable from the person concerned. Any person who prevents or obstructs the execution of any work as aforesaid shall be guilty of an offence against this Regulation.
- 5. Offences against this Regulation shall be punishable by a fine not exceeding £20 and imprisonment not exceeding one month or one or other of such penalties.
- 6. This Regulation shall come into force on the day of the date hereof and may be cited for all purposes as "The New Hebrides Fencing Regulation No. 1 of 1941."
