MADE by the British and French Resident Commissioners under provisions of Article 2, Paragraph 2 and Article 7 of the Anglonch Protocol of 1914.

- 1. Joint Regulation No. 4 of 1938 is hereby repealed.
- 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to kill, wound, capture take the eggs of any bird of the following species without first ving obtained a permit to do so from the Chief Condominium recultural Officer—

- 3. It shall be unlawful for any person to kill, wound, capture take the eggs of any of the following species during the nine onths extending from 1st September to 31st May—lack Duck (also known as Australian Wild Duck)

- [4. (1) It shall be unlawful for any person to kill, wound, putere or take the eggs of any of the following species during the field extending from 1st July to 31st March.

- (2) The Resident Commissioners may by Joint Rules prothe hunting of one or more of these species, on certain islands, a period long enough to permit the re-establishment of the plation of that or those species.
- (3) During the period from 31st March to 1st July in each year, killing of more than ten birds of the same species in any one
- (a) by any one person using any firearm or firearms requiring the issue of a firearms permit; or
- (b) by the use of any firearm requiring the issue of a firearms permit whether used by one person or more than one person

6. It shall be unlawful for any person at any time to sell, upt to sell, buy or export any of the birds the subjects of sections and 5 of this Regulation.

- Hunting at night shall be unlawful throughout the Group times and in respect of all species of birds.
- shall be unlawful for any person to import or purchase ap, net or other device designed for the capture of birds without having obtained a permit from the Chief Condominium ultural Officer.
- (1) Any person who wishes to obtain a special permit to or capture birds as provided for in sections 2 and 8 of this dition shall make written application to the Chief Condominium cultural Officer.
- Every such application shall indicate the species chosen, the see for which it is desired to kill or capture them and the od of capture or slaughter that it is proposed to employ.
- A charge shall be made for each specimen killed or capand the amount of such charge shall be fixed by Joint Rules.

- 10. The Resident Commissioners may make Joint Rules for better carrying out of the provisions of this Regulation.
- 11. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this gulation shall be liable to a fine not exceeding £Stg. 50 or its ivalent in francs at the current rate of exchange or to a term of prisonment not exceeding 8 days or to both such fine and important.
- 12. Any weapon, trap, net or other device used in contravenof the said provisions may be confiscated and disposed of as court shall direct.
- [13. (1) The British and French District Agents, all officers of British and French Police Forces, officers of the Condominium cultural Department, officers of the Customs Department, and person expressly appointed a voluntary game warden for this case by the Resident Commissioners, shall be responsible for the cement of this Regulation.
- (2) Any person appointed a voluntary game warden for the soses of this Regulation, may report the suspected commission offence to any member of the other classes of persons responsor the enforcement of this Regulation, or in accordance with graph (a) of Rule 1 of the Rules of Procedure for Courts of Instance made by the Joint Court on the 29th day of April,
  - 4. This Regulation may be cited as the Joint (Wild Bird ction) Regulation No. 5 of 1962 and shall have effect from the of signature.
