To the North, South and West, by the sea.

To the East—

- (a) By the boundaries of property No. 3
- (b) By the boundaries of property No. 224
- (c) By the boundaries of property No. 223
- (d) By the boundaries of property No. 224
- (e) By the boundaries of property No. 105D
- (f) By the boundaries of property No. 106.
- The two enclaves registered as Nos. 56 and 24 and No. 60 not be affected by the prohibition contained in Section 2 of this lation.
- (3) That parcel of land known as "Norohula" and more cularly delineated and outlined in red on the plan which may spected at the District Agencies of Central District No. 1 shall affected by the prohibition contained in Section 2 of this wation].
